

Nuffield Health Brighton Hospital

Getting here by road, rail or bus





Directions



By road

From the North

Head south towards Brighton on the A23. Just before entering Brighton (Patcham Roundabout), bear left onto the A27–signposted Lewes. Join the A27 heading east for approximately 2 miles then take the slip road on the left by the Sussex University Campus (Falmer exit onto the B2123 to Rottingdean). At the roundabout turn right and head straight across the next mini roundabout towards Woodingdean. After about 1.5 miles, turn right at the traffic lights and the hospital is approximately 500 yards on the left.



By rail

The hospital is situated approximately 4 miles from Brighton mainline station and will take 10 -15 minutes by taxi.

From the West

Head east towards Brighton on the A27. Take the slip road on the left by the Sussex University Campus (Falmer exit onto the B2123 to Rottingdean). At the roundabout turn right and head straight across the next mini roundabout towards Woodingdean. After about 1.5 miles, turn right at the traffic lights and the hospital is approximately 500 yards on the left.

From the East

Head west towards Brighton on the A27. Bear left at the Falmer turn-off – signposted Sussex University and Rottingdean (B2123). At the mini roundabout take the first exit towards Woodingdean. After about 1.5 miles, turn right at the traffic lights and the hospital is approximately 500 yards on the left.



By bus

There is a bus stop directly outside the hospital and Woodingdean is served regularly from the City centre and surrounding areas by the following bus routes. 2A, 22, 22A, 52, 52A, 72, 84, 90, N99. From Brighton Station catch the 22, 22A, 52, N99.
