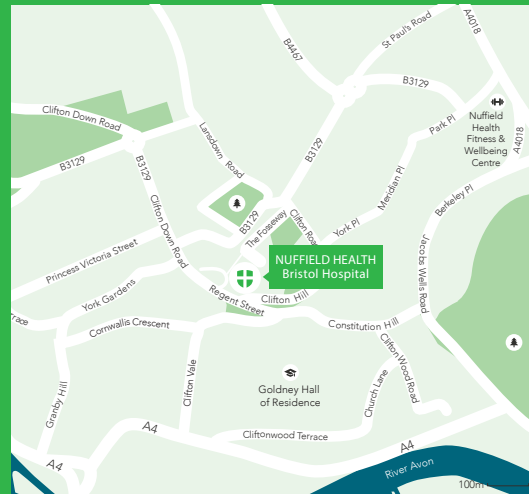

Directions



By road

From the M5 North and M5 South

Exit the M5 at Junction 19. Follow the A369 to Clifton, crossing the Suspension Bridge (toll fee £1). Turn right at the roundabout into Clifton Down Road. Continue onto Regent Street and fork left onto Clifton Hill. The hospital will be on your left.

From the M4 East

If traveling from the East, exit the M4 at Junction 20 for the M5 Southbound. Exit the M5 at Junction 19. Follow the A369 to Clifton, crossing the Suspension Bridge (toll fee £1). Turn right at the roundabout into Clifton Down Road. Continue onto Regent Street and fork left onto Clifton Hill. The hospital will be on your left.

From the M4 West

If traveling from the West, exit the M4 at Junction 22 (signposted The Southwest) onto the M49. Follow the signs for the M5 Southbound and exit the M5 at Junction 19. Follow the A369 to Clifton, crossing the Suspension Bridge (toll fee £1). Turn right at the roundabout into Clifton Down Road. Continue onto Regent Street and fork left onto Clifton Hill. The hospital will be on your left.

Parking

There is patient parking on-site, with metered street parking immediately adjacent to the hospital entrance.



By rail

Rail passengers are recommended to alight at Bristol Temple Meads Station. Bristol Parkway is further away on the outskirts of the city. From Temple Meads Station or the Bristol Bus/Coach Station, you have the choice of a taxi, or Bus 8 or 9 to Clifton Village.



By bus

Alight at Clifton Down Road and follow the road down into Regent Street, past two pedestrian crossings. Fork left into Clifton Hill. The hospital is clearly signposted on the left-hand side at the beginning of Clifton Hill.



By cycle

Cycling is a quick and sustainable way to travel to the hospital. It is surrounded by quiet roads which are marked as recommended cycle routes by other cyclists as shown on the Bristol City Cycle Maps. Cycle parking is conveniently provided for visitors and patients adjacent to the main hospital building.
