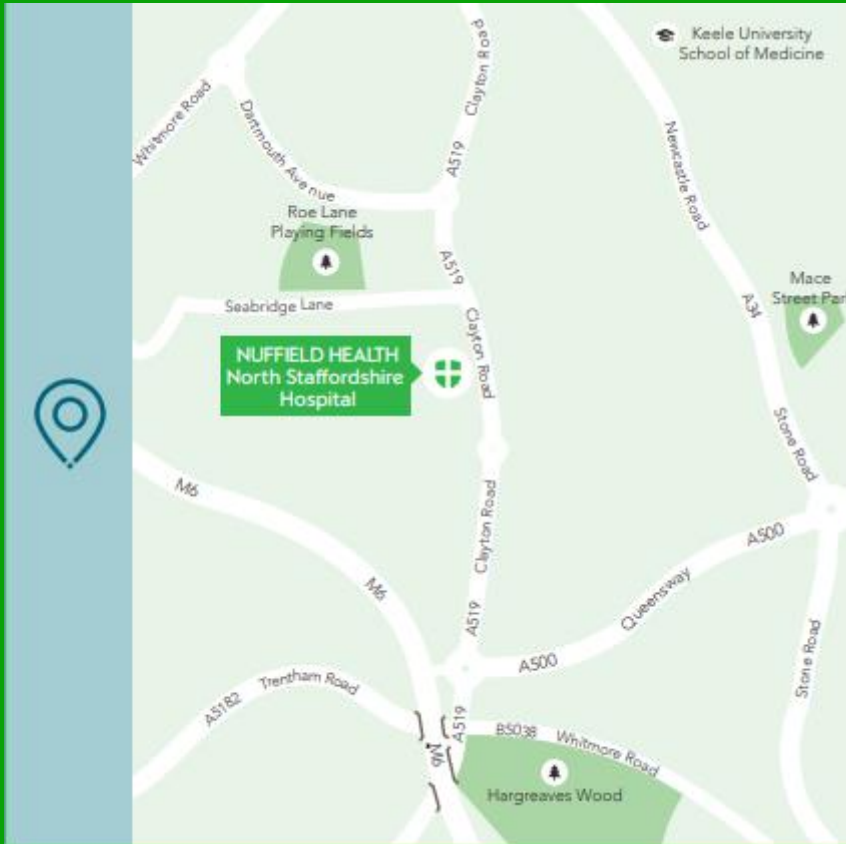
Whatever your professional interests or goals, Nuffield Health North Staffordshire Hospital is here to support you.
