

# COVID-19 antibody testing for the workplace



# Helping your business get back on track post COVID-19

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic we have launched an antibody test which can be used to test whether your employees have had the virus. The test does not however confirm if a person currently has the virus and if anyone is presenting symptoms they cannot receive the test and should not attend work.

COVID-19 is a new virus that has only been identifiable in the human population for approximately 8 months. We are doing all we can to learn about how to manage the diagnosis, treatment and containment of the virus. To learn more about the spread and immunity against the virus the use of antibody testing will grow in value and importance.

However, we do advise that as the test result will only determine the presence of antibodies detected on the day of testing, repeat testing for employees with negative results should be considered as part of the process.

## How testing works



### Testing locations

#### **At a Nuffield Health medical centre:**

Employees can attend their local Nuffield Health medical centre at a location convenient for them where a clinician will carry out testing.

**At your offices:** Testing can be arranged at your offices where one of our clinicians can deliver up to 24 tests a day. Testing should only be carried out on employees who are not symptomatic. To ensure the safety of employees and the clinician, there are specific room set up requirements to conduct the testing. Our team will work with you to manage all logistics for the day. Please note, half day sessions are not available for this service.



### What the testing involves

The test includes a full blood sample test taken by venipuncture from a vein, please note this is not a finger prick test. If your employees have a health assessment booked with us where a full blood sample is expected, then the antibody test will be included.



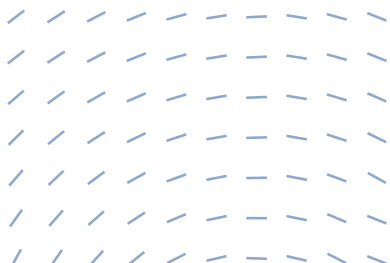
### To access results

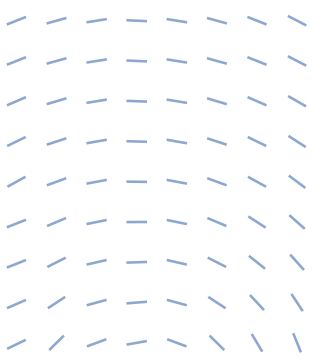
Test results will be available online within 72 hours. Individuals will receive an email with instructions on how to set up their secure online personal portal where results can be accessed. The pre-test information leaflet will contain interpretation of positive or negative results.



### Interpreting test results

Prior to the day of testing, employees will be asked to complete a pre-COVID-19 questionnaire and will be provided with an information sheet which includes how to interpret a positive or negative result.





## Testing locations and pricing

Testing can be carried out at the following locations. Employees can access a test near their home or at work. A blended service can be offered to provide employees with a choice of locations for their convenience.

**At your offices** – Up to 24 people can be seen in a day

**At a Nuffield Health medical centre**

£65 per person

Testing price includes full testing, provision of PPE, clinician and other ancillary costs.
