## Fertility Assessments

Often a patient's first step, a fertility assessment or MOT is designed to give you an idea of your fertility potential, either together with your partner or as a single person.

Female & Male Fertility Assessment (includes ultrasound scan, AMH blood test, semen analysis, nurse consultation)	£299

We stock competitively priced fertility medication at our hospital pharmacy. Prescribed medication and doses vary from one patient to another. We have therefore developed price ranges for the common treatment types giving you an idea of the likely cost of your treatment to enable you to budget accordingly.

Payment in full for treatment must be received in advance of starting treatment.

If you have any further questions please do not hesitate to contact a member of customer services for more information.

\*\* Although rare, in the event that an IVFI cycle is abandoned prior to egg collection, a refund of £1,700 will be due – a further refund of £450 will be due if you have paid for ICSI. If an egg collection procedure is performed and no eggs are recovered, a refund of £400 will be due – a further refund of £450 will be due if you have paid for ICSI. If an egg collection procedure is performed, eggs are recovered and no embryo is transferred a refund of £300 will be due. In the event that an IVF cycle is converted to IUI a refund of £1,500 will be due. In the event that an ICSI cycle results in no eggs suitable for injection a refund of £650 will be due.

\*\*\* Although rare, in the event that an IUI cycle is abandoned prior to insemination a refund of £200 will be due.

\*\*\*\* Although rare, in the event that an FET cycle is abandoned prior to embryo transfer a refund of £250 will be due. In the event that no embryo is available to transfer a refund of £200 will be due.

Patients are asked to pay consultation and diagnostic fees on the day of the appointment.

Payment in full for treatment must be received in advance of starting treatment.
