Mr Venkatachalam is an Orthopaedic Surgeon specialising in Shoulder, Elbow, Wrist and Hand Surgery.

Common problems dealt with include:

Shoulder: Rotator cuff tears, arthritis, Impingement, shoulder dislocations/ subluxations (instabilities), sports injuries, fractures, stiffness (frozen shoulders), trauma

Elbow: ligament injuries (instabilities), tennis/ golfers elbow, trapped nerve at the elbow (cubital tunnel syndrome), arthritis, loose bodies, biceps/ triceps problems, sports injuries, trauma

Wrist/ Hand problems: ligament injuries (instabilities), arthritis, scaphoid problems, small joint arthritis, Rheumatoid arthritis, carpal tunnel syndrome, trigger finger, Dupuytrens' contracture, DeQuiverans' tenosynovitis, thumb base arthritis, trauma

Sports related upper limb injuries

Mr Venkatachalam was selected for a National training number in Northern Deanery and he trained as a registrar in various hospitals in the North East. He was awarded two prestigious upper limb specialist units at Wrightington Hospital and Northern General Hospital Sheffield.

Mr Venkatachalam has also been awarded visiting fellowships from national organisations such as British Elbow and Shoulder Society (BESS) and British Orthopaedics Sports Traumatology Arthroscopy Association (BOSTAA).

He has visited and interacted with internationally renowned shoulder surgeons in San Antonio (Texas, USA), San Diego (California, USA), Lyon (France) and Nice (France) through these fellowships.

Mr Venkatachalam is actively involved in research, training of junior doctors, allied health professionals (nurses, physiotherapists) and education for general practitioners in the region and nationally. He is also a faculty in various regional/ national courses for FRCS Orthopaedics, shoulder arthroscopy and arthroplasty courses.

In his spare time he enjoys spending time with his young family as well as playing badminton and travelling.
