Nuffy's ears twitched. "Woah," they said. "That's pretty cool."

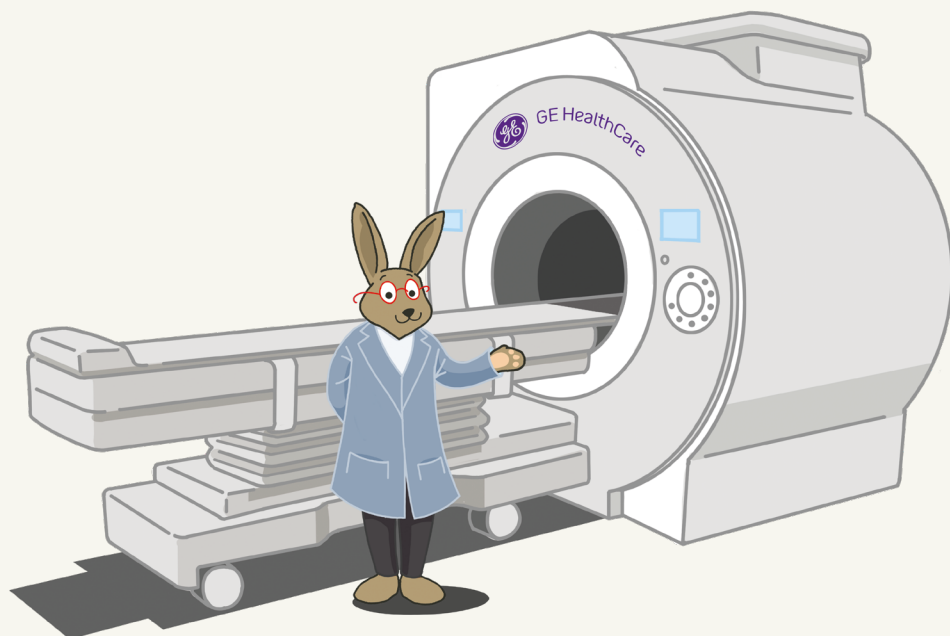
Radiographer Rabbit told Nuffy two important rules.

Nuffy lay perfectly still and imagined being home in the cave.

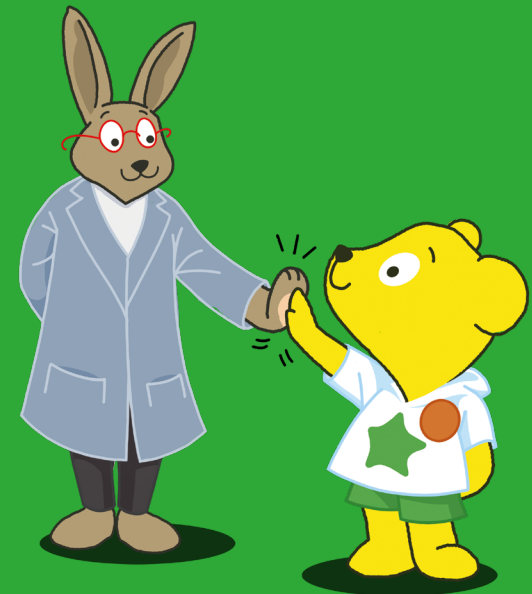
Clapping paws, tapping pots, and banging drums with friends.
