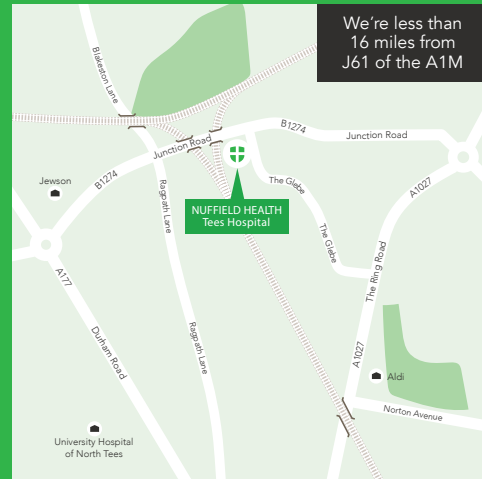

Directions



By road

There is limited free parking at the hospital, with designated disabled bays.

From the A19 North or A19 South

Exit the A19 at the Norton turning (A1027): If travelling Southbound, take the 3rd roundabout exit onto the A1027. If travelling Northbound, take the 1st roundabout exit onto the A1027. Follow the A1027 until you reach the next roundabout. Take the 3rd exit onto Junction Road signposted Carlton B1274. The hospital is located about $\frac{3}{4}$ miles ahead, on the left-hand side.

From the A1(M) North

Leave the A1 at Junction 60 and at the 1st roundabout: If travelling Southbound, take the 1st exit onto the A689 (Teesside). If travelling Northbound, take the 3rd exit onto the A689 (Teesside). At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit sign posted A689 Teesside. After about 2 miles at the next roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A177 sign posted Stockton. Continue on the A177 for about 6 miles. Warning: Speed cameras along the A177. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit onto Junction Road. The hospital is located about $\frac{3}{4}$ miles ahead, on the right-hand side.



By rail

Darlington Railway station is the closest main line station. A taxi to the hospital from Darlington station takes about 25 minutes. Changing at Darlington you can travel to local stations at Stockton, Thornaby and Middlesbrough. A taxi from one of the local stations takes about 10 minutes to the hospital.



By bus

Stagecoach buses 37 and 38 run from Middlesbrough via Stockton and Norton Village to outside the hospital. From Hartlepool and Billingham take Stagecoach bus 36 to Norton village.
