


New hip replacement technique with shorter hospital stay.

SuperPath® is a new tissue-sparing or “minimally invasive” total hip replacement technique that is now being performed by Mr Michael Cronin, Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon at Nuffield Health Warwickshire Hospital.

With SuperPath® there is no surgical dislocation of the hip. By never surgically dislocating the hip, there is less trauma to the surrounding muscles and tendons and no muscles are cut during surgery. With this technique, the implant is built inside the body, so the hip is never twisted into unnatural positions. This leaves more intact tissue, specifically the short external rotator tendons and gluteus medius muscle. These muscles are normally responsible for preventing dislocation.

Mr Cronin says of the procedure: “By causing less soft tissue trauma, patients are in less pain and often walk the same day as their surgery and leave hospital the next day. Our physios have commented how much faster patients progress”.
